After Charfield village follow road (straight over at roundabout) and after passing Renishaw on your LEFT and before reaching the Wotton town signpost, turn RIGHT towards the school (direction Wickwar, Chipping Sodbury, Yate). Turn RIGHT into school and park in second car park on the right.
